

Partners Programme Monday 19th September 2022

08.15am Meet in the Lobby

08.30am Coach pick-up from the Royal Marine for the drive to Glendalough Visitor Centre, a beauty spot in the Wicklow Mountains.

09.40am Arrive Glendalough Visitor Centre



Take a beautiful **50 minute** round trip walk to the Upper Lake. From the Visitor Centre take the well-marked path past the Lower Lake and on to the Upper Lake. Make your way to the Monastic Site which is steeped in history. Time permitting, visit the tourist shop or the stalls selling lovely woollen items and other souvenirs.



10.40am – Depart Glendalough

11.25am – Arrive Powerscourt

Visit the beautiful Powerscourt Estate, voted 3rd best gardens in the world, with formal gardens, sweeping terraces. There is also a range of shops to browse. Have lunch in the cafeteria in an area set aside. Each person will go to the counter to choose their own lunch.



1.45pm – Depart Powerscourt

2.25pm – Arrive back at The Royal Marine

3.00pm – Depart The Royal Marine (Partners and Delegates)

4.00pm – Arrive at The Guinness Storehouse

Self-guided tour of the factory, ending in the Guinness shop with a pint or a soft drink.

6.00pm – Depart Guinness Storehouse and get off the coach in the City OR opt to go back to the hotel. Evening meals, whether in the City or the hotel will be at the Delegates' own expense.
