CM insurance - Endorsement 1369

Special conditions: submerged and deep-well pumps

This endorsement forms part of section 1 and is subject otherwise to the terms, provisions, conditions and exclusions contained in the *policy of insurance* or endorsed thereon.

1. Conditions

- 1.1. The *insurer* shall not indemnify the *insured* in respect of loss of or damage to submerged and deep-well pumps unless the insured arranges at his own expense an annual overhaul and provides the *insurer* with reports on this overhaul.
- 1.2. The *insured* shall inform the *insurer* of such an overhaul in good time so that the insurer's agent may be present during the overhaul at the insurer's expense.
- 2. Special exclusions 2.1. The *insurer* shall not indemnify the *insured* for loss or damage resulting from
 - 2.1.1. sand erosion,
 - 2.1.2. operating without water,
 - 2.1.3. a collapse of the well,
 - 2.1.4. destruction of tubes or reinforced walls.
