Optional Site Visit

This site visit will be on the Wednesday afternoon after the end of the Conference, it will be for a limited number on a first come first serve basis.

It will encompass a visit to the project exhibition centre where we can give a presentation of the project and look at models of the more complex parts of the project. This will be followed by a visit to one of the major contracts the N105 contract to view a working site. We will do this from two overhead bridges which cross the Novena junction and look down on the site offering an ideal view. This is in a public space so there will be no need to go through inductions or wear PPE. The site is quite close to the Fullerton and we'll go there by MRT.



The North-South Corridor (NSC) will be Singapore's longest Transit Priority Corridor. It's part of Singapore's Imagine a Greener Future. The project is part of the overall aim to create a city with fewer cars, more walking, cycling and public transport. They will be above ground with vehicular traffic underground. The project is expected to complete from 2027, it will directly connect the Northern region and the city centre. All civil contracts for the construction of the tunnels and viaducts have been awarded and construction is currently underway.
